SCHEDULE Mandatory Licensing Conditions

1.—(1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—

(i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or

(ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

4.—(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5. The responsible person shall ensure that–

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures–

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Supply of alcohol

1. No supply of alcohol shall be made under this Premises Licence at a time:

a) When there is no designated supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence

b) When the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her personal licence is suspended.

2. Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Steps Taken To Promote the Licensing Objectives

The club is a members and guests only club operating for the benefit of freemasonry in Bourne and the masonic lodges that meet within the Masonic centre.

The premises consist of a single storey building which has been internally modified under change of use application S10/2755 to suit the activities of a masonic centre, it has a capacity of 150.

The previous occupation was a snooker club/sports bar.

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

A risk based approach will be taken, policies put in place and signage to support policies.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Members and guests only.

Water and soft drinks to be available.

Secure and discreet storage of valuables.

c) Public safety

First aid provision.

Fire Safety policy.

Building design and layout.

Maintenance policy.

Signage to support policy and control measures.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Dispersal policy.

Parking policy.

Members and guests only.

Designated smoking area.

Zero tolerance of nuisance.

e) The protection of children from harm

Members and guests only.

No gaming machines or similar.

No nudity or similar.

Policies regarding third parties.

Under the Licesnsing Act 2003 it is a requirement that the licence holder ensures that an age verification policy is in place whereby any person appearing to be under 18 must be asked to produce on request ID bearing their date of birth, a photograph and a holographic mark before being serviced with alcohol.

All those who serve alcohol on the premises, whether on behalf of the Bourne Freemasons Club or others, must be over 21 and aware of this policy. They must also be aware of fake ID cards and proxy purchasing and be clear that it is against the law to sell alcohol to anyone under 18.

Only photocard driving licences or PASS accredited ID cards will be acceptable as proof of age. If any doubt exists the sale/supply ,ust be refused.

Suitable and appropriate signage will be displayed in the bar area to support this policy.
